5/13/08 - Plff was riding her bicycle northbound in the bicycle lane adjacent to SE Milwaukie Boulevard in Portland, Oregon. Plff contended the Def.'s driver was operating a work truck when he failed to yield the right-of-way turning across her lane of travel and striking her. Two (2) months prior to trial, Plff quit her job and became a full time dancer. At trial, the defense played a video of her dancing upside down on a pole.
